



Churchill Avenue and Scott Street Reconstruction Open House #2

The City of Ottawa invites you to attend an open house to review the plans for the proposed reconstruction of Churchill Avenue and Scott Street.

The City of Ottawa has finalized the preliminary design for Churchill Avenue from Carling Avenue to Scott Street and Scott Street from Churchill Avenue to Winona Avenue. Subject to feedback from Open House #2, the City intends to undertake the detailed design. Future open houses will provide the public with an opportunity to comment on detailed design proposals.

Within the limits of the project, the City of Ottawa has identified a requirement for the rehabilitation and/or replacement of its linear infrastructure. Included in the scope of this project is:

- Rehabilitation/replacement of the watermain.
- Rehabilitation/replacement of the sanitary sewers.
- Rehabilitation/replacement and extension of the storm sewers.
- Surface drainage improvements.
- Adjustments to pavement widths, new curbs, sidewalks, and road structure.
- Street lighting and traffic control signal modifications.
- Water and sewer service replacement to the property line (upgrades to the services on private property, including replacement of lead water service pipes, may also be considered but at the property owner's cost).
- The project also provides an opportunity to implement identified traffic calming measures, improvements to transit service, and other features deemed beneficial to the project.

It had been anticipated that funding for construction would be included in the 2009 Capital Budget. However, the Draft Operating and Capital Budget tabled on October 14, 2008 did not provide funding for construction in 2009. Accordingly, the expected construction timing and phasing details are as follows:

- Phase 1: Churchill – Carling to Duncairn, length 550 m, construction in 2010*
- Phase 2: Churchill – Duncairn to Byron, length 725 m, construction in 2011*
- Phase 3: Churchill – Byron to Scott, and Scott – Churchill to Winona, length 550m, construction in 2012*

* Subject to Budget approval by City Council.

At the open house, you will be able to review background information and the preliminary design proposals, as well; comments on the City's recommendations that are to be implemented would be welcomed.



The project is being planned in accordance with the *Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Guidelines* as a Schedule "A+" project.

Representatives from the City, the consultant and the ward councillor will be available to discuss the project and answer your questions. Your input is an important part of the consultation process.
